
Anne Marie Maes

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Short bio

AnneMarie Maes is an artist who has been studying the close interactions and co-evolutions within urban ecosystems. Her research practice combines art and science, with a keen interest in DIY technologies and biotechnology. She works with a range of biological, digital and traditional media, including live organisms. Her artistic research is materialised in technoorganic objects that are inspired by factual/fictional stories; in artefacts that are a combination of digital fabrication and craftsmanship; in installations that reflect both the problem and the (possible) solution, in multispecies collaborations, in polymorphic forms and models created by eco-data. With a history of artist residencies at prominent research centers and art institutions, Anne Marie Maes continues to explore the symbiotic relationship between humans, nature, and technology. In a world where art and science often exist in separate spheres, she invites us to explore the frontiers of knowledge and creativity through captivating works. On the rooftop of her studio in Brussels (BE) she has created an open-air lab and experimental garden where she studies the processes that nature employs to create form. Her long-term projects 'The Bee Agency' as well as 'the Laboratory for Form and Matter' and 'Sensorial Skins' - in which she experiments with bacteria and living textiles - provide a framework that has inspired a wide range of installations, sculptures, photography works, objects and books – all at the intersection of art, science and technology.
